## **On-site Vaccination**

Your employer has arranged for you to receive a flue vaccination on-site.

At the vaccination site, you must provide the **agreement number** and present your **Yellow healthcard.** If your workplace requires any additional documentation, it will be listed in the box below.

## The Process

It's simple and straightforward. Just show up at the vaccination location your company has arranged with the pharmacy, on the agreed date and time. Remember to bring your yellow health insurance card and provide the necessary information upon arrival.

You will then be vaccinated by one of our certified vaccinators. After the vaccination, a 15-minute observation period is recommended. Afterwards, you can continue your day as usual.

## Why Get Vaccinated Against Influenza?

Influenza is a common and highly contagious viral illness that affects many people every autumn and winter. Each year, 5-15% of the population contracts the flu, and during an epidemic, up to 20% of the population may become ill.

For most people, influenza causes symptoms such as fever, muscle aches, headaches, fatigue, coughing, and a sore throat.

Getting vaccinated is one of the most reliable ways to reduce the risk of catching the flu.

The flu vaccine has very few side effects. The most common reactions are temporary swelling and soreness at the injection site, mild fever, or a headache.

These side effects usually resolve within 1-2 days.
