

On-site Vaccination

Your workplace has chosen to offer you influenza vaccination at the company premises.

On the day of vaccination, please bring your Danish health insurance card (yellow card) or your passport if you do not have a Danish health insurance card. Please also bring your agreement number if your company uses different agreement numbers for individual departments.

What to expect

Getting vaccinated is easy. Simply arrive at the agreed location during the specified time slot. We recommend wearing a T-shirt or other clothing that allows easy access to your upper arm.

You will be vaccinated by one of our certified vaccinators. After your vaccination, we recommend that you remain on site for observation for 15 minutes. You can then continue your day as normal.

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Why get vaccinated against influenza?

Influenza (flu) is a common and highly contagious viral illness that affects many people every autumn and winter. Each year, 5–15% of the population contracts the flu, and during an epidemic, up to 20% of the population may become ill.

For most people, flu causes symptoms such as fever, muscle aches, headaches, fatigue, coughing, and a sore throat.

Getting vaccinated is one of the most reliable ways to reduce the risk of catching the flu.

Side effects from flu vaccination are generally mild and temporary. The most common side effects are swelling and soreness at the injection site, as well as mild fever or headache.

These side effects usually resolve within 1–2 days.
